COVID-19 VACCINATION SCHEDULE

The Ministry of Health and Human Services (MHHS) would like to inform the public that COVID-19 vaccines, including the new booster will be available at the Palau National Gym every Tuesday and Thursday starting October 18 until end of November, as indicated on the schedule below.

Time/Dates	Venue/POD	Available Vaccines and Recommendations
4:30pm -6:30pm	Palau National Gym	<ul style="list-style-type: none">6 months through 4 years should get primary series (doses 1, 2 and 3). Boosters are not yet recommended for this age group.
October 18		<ul style="list-style-type: none">5 – 11 years old should get primary doses (1st and 2nd doses) and get original (monovalent) booster, at least 5 months after 2nd dose

November 1		<ul style="list-style-type: none">12 - 17 years old are recommended to receive the new Pfizer (bivalent) booster at least 2 months after 2nd dose or (monovalent) booster.

November 15		<ul style="list-style-type: none">18 years and older are recommended to receive the new Pfizer or Moderna (bivalent) booster, at least 2 months after 2nd dose or last (monovalent) booster.

MHHS encourages everyone to get vaccinated or get boosters when eligible for best protection against COVID-19. Getting a COVID-19 vaccine after you recover from a COVID-19 infection provides added protection against COVID-19. You may receive your COVID-19 vaccine or booster at least 3 months after a COVID infection.
