### REVISED AUGUST 2022 SCHEDULE FOR COVID-19 VACCINES AT THE PCC CAFETERIA

The Ministry of Health and Human Services (MHHS) would like to inform the public of the COVID-19 vaccination schedule at the PCC Cafeteria every Wednesday, Thursday and Friday (unless indicated below or a holiday\*) for August 2022.

Wednesdays Thursdays, and Fridays  (8/3, 8/4, 8/5, 8/10, 8/12, 8/17, 8/18, 8/19, 8/24, 8/25, 8/26, 8/31)  4:00pm – 6:00pm  *No vaccination on 8/11/22.	Palau Community College (PCC) Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Moderna – All doses and boosters for 18+</li><li>• Pfizer – all doses and boosters for 6 months +</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children ages 6 months to 4 years of age are now eligible for COVID-19 vaccination.</li><li>• Everyone ages 5 or older can get 1 booster, five months after completing their COVID-19 primary series.</li><li>• Adults 50 years and older can choose to get a second booster, at least 4 months after the first booster with either Moderna or the Pfizer vaccine. It is advisable that a person who gets infected with COVID-19 after the first booster wait at least 90 days before getting the 2<sup>nd</sup> booster.</li></ul>

MHHS encourages everyone to get vaccinated or get boosters when eligible for best protection against COVID-19. To support families with rising costs of transportation, fuel vouchers will be given to first time vaccine recipients (ages 6 mos. – 4 years).
