REVISED JULY 2022 SCHEDULE FOR COVID-19 VACCINES AT THE PCC CAFETERIA

The Ministry of Health and Human Services (MHHS) would like to inform the public of the following changes to the COVID-19 vaccination schedule at the PCC Cafeteria every Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, effective July 20, 2022 for the rest of the month.

Wednesdays Thursdays, and Fridays (7/20, 7/21, 7/22, 7/27, 7/28, 7/29) 4:00pm – 7:00pm	Palau Community College (PCC) Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Moderna – All doses and boosters for 18+• Pfizer – all doses and boosters for 6 months +	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Everyone ages 5 or older can get 1 booster, five months after completing their COVID-19 primary series.• Adults 50 years and older can choose to get a second booster, at least 4 months after the first booster with either Moderna or the Pfizer vaccine. It is advisable that a person who gets infected with COVID-19 after the first booster wait at least 90 days before getting the 2nd booster.• Children ages 6 months to 4 years of age are now eligible for COVID-19 vaccination.

MHHS encourages everyone to get vaccinated or get boosters when eligible for best protection against COVID-19. To support families with rising costs of transportation, fuel vouchers will be given to first time vaccine recipients (ages 6 mos. – 4 years).
